Ask for volunteers to get involved with the fight for decency and against pornography by having them do one project -- like passing a licensing or zoning ordinance to control sexually oriented businesses in your community, or holding a letter writing coffee hour targeting sponsors of indecent shows.

Assemble a toolbox of pamphlets, referrals, books, blocking software and web sites to help with healing and accountability.
